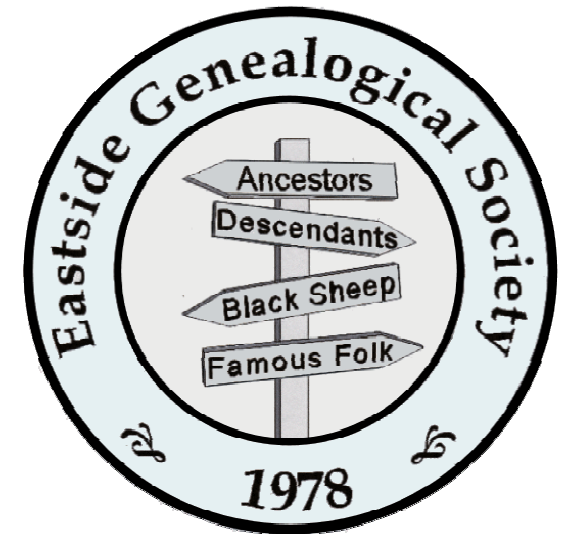

## The Eastside Genealogical Society

The Eastside Genealogical Society (EGS) provides members a forum for learning, and the exchange of information related to genealogy. The Society obtains and provides resources for use by members, encourages genealogical research and education, and provides community outreach through programs, classes, seminars and assistance at the Bellevue Regional Library.

### EGS Research Help

The EGS provides volunteers at the Bellevue Regional Library to assist researchers with questions and problems. The volunteers are in Room 6 on the second floor of the library on Tuesdays from 7 - 9 p.m. and on Wednesdays from 1 p.m. - 3 pm. There is no charge for this help.

### EGS and the Bellevue Regional Library

Since 1995, the EGS has purchased over 1,000 genealogy-related books to add to the collection at the Bellevue Regional Library. Titles include how- to- books for beginners, and books on research in various states, regions, and countries. Books on immigrant ancestors, migration trails, Revolutionary and Civil War veterans, translations of various documents in foreign languages, as well as books on writing your family's history are available, and are listed in the King County Library System Catalog at <http://www.kcls.org> You can find these books in the Reference section, NE corner on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.

## Benefits of Your Membership
